Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program Outcomes

- 842 households requested assistance with housing
- 803 households were identified as homeless or at imminent risk
- 134 literally homeless households obtained permanent housing
- 708 families were diverted from homelessness

Food Program - SCCAP distributed over 597,972 pounds of USDA food and a total of 737,051 lbs of donated and Holiday food distributed through partnerships with volunteer organizations serving their community at a value of \$762,263.50. (12, 907 Emergency USDA Food Boxes were distributed)
